

ORDER OF ST. NICHOLAS THE MIRACLE WORKER

- *Founded on July 19, 1929 by His Imperial Highness Grand Duke Kyrill Vladimirovich Romanov, pretender to the throne, in memory of Tsar Nicholas II.*
- *All veterans of the Imperial Russian Armed Forces on active duty during WWI were eligible to wear this award.*
- *Certain variations exist, for instance members of the Imperial Red Cross have a red cross in the center medallion instead of St. Nicholas and cipher of Nicholas II appears in the center for non-Christian.*
