

P. V. Pashkov Collection of Orders and badges of the Russian Emigration, 1920-1944

All items in this category came originally from P. V. Pashkov Collection of Orders and Badges of the Russian Emigration. Most of them were part of the self published manuscript, by P. V. Pashkov in Paris in 1944. Badges and manuscript were passed over to an American collector.

Notes:

- Badges in this category are bronze or brass, unless noted otherwise.
- Badges have a screwback construction, unless noted other wise.
- Please refer to illustration for the size reference and for enamel color.
- They all in choice collectable condition, however some are missing screwback parts. Only items with noticeable condition problems will be stated as such.
- Cataloguer found some discrepancy and different attribution of several badges by P. Paskov, O. Selsky, A. Okorokjov's and A. Chichikalov's works. We tend to follow the earlier attribution, which would be correctly called "The Source". Needless to say, P. V. Pashkov – the pioneer of collecting and researching this important memorabilia was an eye witness and a part of the events back in 1930's and on.

In any case, this extremely interesting area of collecting does require much of additional research. It is the only reason we would gladly see this group intact in one hands, rather than in a trade.
