2340 **Volinsky Life Guards Regiment. 1917.** Silver. P/B 3.1.23. Inscribed recipients name: Ya. Kuiman. *Rare* and very popular badge, as Volinsky regiment was the very first one to side insurgent people during the February 1917 revolution. Very much thought after by both Imperial and Soviet era collectors

2341 **To the Fighters of Revolution. 1917.** White metal. 28 mm. Chep 1121

Condition: Choice extremely fine \$ 100

The official meaning of this and the following medal is unknown. It is believed, that they were made by the special request of the War Minister and were given to every soldier going to War. They were not available at free trade as jettons of the lot 2343.
